Tune in to a local television or radio stations. Officials may use local radio and television stations to make announcements.

## Emergency Sirens

Are tested at noon the 4th Wednesday of every month. Should you hear them at any other time please go indoors and turn on Radio/TV for further information.

## KC911

Emergency officials may use the telephone ring-down system to share information by telephone. Therefore it is important to stay off your telephone during an emergency.

## PREPARE YOUR FAMILY

**PLAN RESOURCES TO SHELTER-IN-PLACE FOR**

- ✓ Maintain a small family first-aid kit
- ✓ Develop a family communication plan with an out-of-town friend or relative as a contact
- ✓ Develop a fire escape plan for your entire family and practice it
- ✓ Keep a 3-day supply of your prescription medications on hand
- ✓ Keep fresh supply of batteries for flashlights and battery-operated broadcast radios
- ✓ Keep a supply of bottled water (at least one gallon per day for each member of your household) Replace that water supply every two years
- ✓ Keep a supply of non-perishable foods
- ✓ Store important documents, prescription medicines and vital supplies in a mobile format
- ✓ Develop a plan to care for your pets
- ✓ Advance planning with emergency management officials for special needs population
- ✓ Keep cash on hand for emergencies should ATMs not be functioning
- ✓ Plan for your children should you become unreachable. Consult an attorney regarding permanent custody of your minor children. Make prearrangements with family or trusted friends
