SPECIFICATIONS: The following specifications are intended to describe ammunition for the Kanawha County Sheriff's Office (KCSO) and the details contained in these specifications are not designed to exclude any vendor from bidding, but are offered as a means of describing the needs of the Kanawha County Sheriff's Office. All specifications are minimum requirements.

**Request for Quotation
Kanawha County Sheriff's Office**

The Kanawha County Sheriff's Office is requesting a price quote for ammunition for use by members of the department both for official duty and training. All items will be shipped to the Kanawha County Sheriff's Office at 301 Virginia Street E, Charleston WV 25301.

All quotes should reflect the following:

- 1) Immediately acceptable manufacturers will be CCI, Speer, Federal, Remington, or Winchester. Any other brand will require approval by the KCSO.
- 2) All ammunition will be newly manufactured, brass cased, with non-corrosive powder and primer.
- 3) Ammunition which is described as "**Duty**" will have nickel plated casings, water proofed primer and flash suppressant applied to the powder. Duty ammo will be that which is designed and marketed as "Law Enforcement" ammunition.
- 4) No rifle bullets using a polymer nose tip will be considered.
- 5) Rifle bullets should be constructed so that the jacket and core are bonded together by chemical bond or electrolysis. Acceptable projectile weights are between 62 and 68 grains.

- 6) Initial order should be for the "Expected Quantity", depending on budgetary constraints additional orders may follow. Vendor should specify an expiration date for the submitted pricing.
- 7) The price listed in the "Price/1000" column will be our cost per 1,000 rounds of the ammo proposed by the vendor. No other price / round amount will be acceptable.

Bidders should complete the attached specification sheet with the manufacture's name, part number, price per 1,000 rounds and the quantity of rounds per shipping case.
