BID DUE DATE: **Bids must be received in a sealed envelope, with “Shawnee Sports Complex Security Equipment – Avigilon Camera System” and the date and time of the bid opening on the outside of the envelope on or before Friday, June 15, 2018, at 11:00 a.m., in the Kanawha County Commission Purchasing Office, 407 Virginia Street, East, Third Floor, Room 229, Charleston, West Virginia 25301 (P.O. Box 3627, Charleston, WV 25336). *Faxed or electronically submitted bids will not be accepted.***

The winning bidder will have access to the facility beginning July 10th, 2018. Bidders must include in their proposal an agreement to have all necessary equipment and personnel to begin installation by that date. Bidder must agree to this term to be fully compliant, but bidders may detail any reservations or alternatives wished to be considered.

Additional construction will be ongoing. The selected bidder must also agree to a phased installation approach that will be coordinated with and approved by the project’s lead contractor, Hayslett Construction or an authorized County Commission designee. The phased installation must allow for partial use of the system(s) as construction proceeds. (i.e. if only half of fiber or camera locations are available for installation, those cameras and fiber should be installed and ready to actively use.) Bidder must agree to these terms be fully compliant, but bidders may detail any reservations or alternatives wished to be considered.

Camera System

Q: What network connectivity will there be between Shawnee Park and Metro for the Alarm System?

A: Currently there are plans for the camera system to be given a secure, static, public ip that can be used for the connection directly. However, if the bidder requires a VPN connection for the alarm system to work, please specify in the response, and a VPN connection will be supplied by the County.

Q: Are jumpers to the Fiber switch required?

A: Yes, all jumpers and other equipment necessary for a turnkey system are required to be provided by the bidder.

Q: Are there power drops at remote camera locations?

A: Power will be provided at camera locations. Final camera locations will be determined at time of installation.

Q: Is there preexisting conduit at camera locations?

A: Yes, conduit is already in place for fiber cable runs.
