Kanawha County Continues to Accept Resumes for Open Board Seat on the Kanawha-Charleston Board of Health

Charleston, W.Va. – The Kanawha County Commission has an opening on the Kanawha-Charleston Board of Health due to a resignation. The Commission is accepting resumes for the open seat for persons who are interested in serving on the Board. Resumes must be submitted to the County Manager by Thursday January 24th. The Kanawha Charleston Health Department By-Laws place certain limitations on Board Members. Due to the current make-up of the Board, the Kanawha County Commission must fill this vacancy with a Board Member who resides in Kanawha County in Magisterial District 3 or 4. Also, as there are already 3 registered Democrats on the current Board of Health, the County is required to appoint a member from another political party or with no political affiliation.

Public interviews of the candidates for the Board Position will be conducted during a Kanawha County Commission Meeting. Candidates will be notified of the date and time of that meeting. For questions regarding the vacancy, please contact Jennifer Herrald, County Manager at 304.357.0628.
