
RE: ESTATE PROCEEDINGS AND DEADLINES

ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER

At a regular session of the County Commission came Andrew Gunnoe, Fiduciary Supervisor and advised the Commission that due to the current COVID -19 crisis and the requirement for social distancing, there is a need to delay deadlines for estate proceedings to include, filing the appraisal of the estate forms and the time period for creditors to file a claim against an estate. This will reduce the need for people to leave their homes and protect the health and safety of the citizens of Kanawha County.

The County Commission **ORDERS** and **DIRECTS** all estate proceedings and deadlines as of March 25, 2020 are extended to April 30, 2020. The Commission may extend this order in the event the public health crisis continues.
