

Commissioner Carper asked if the petitioner was present, he was not. Steve Duffield informed the Commission that he has 2 petitioners for Tuesday's hearing, the Charleston Town Center and the Marriott. However, Mr. Duffield stated he believes the Marriott will settle before Tuesday. Randy Saunders informed the Commission that he told the petitioner that they must present clean and present proof that the assessment by the Assessor is wrong. Andrew Gunnoe stated the Assessors office received the discovery they requested. Mr. Saunders stated yes, they received it on Sept. 30th. Mr. Duffield stated he originally asked for it a week after Hull Properties purchased the mall but never received it. Mr. Saunders informed the Commission that they have not sent the insurance declaration page he requested. The hearing for the Town Center is set for Tuesday, Oct. 12th at 11:00am.




