

APPOINTMENT TO THE OFFICE OF COUNTY COMMISSIONER OF KANAWHA COUNTY

The Kanawha County Commission is accepting applicants for appointment to a vacancy on the Kanawha County Commission. The appointee will serve an existing term through December 31, 2026. As required by W. Va. Code §3-10-7, the appointee must be of the same political party as the officeholder vacating the office and, therefore, must be a registered member of the Republican Party and reside in Magisterial District 3 or 4. The appointee must meet the requirements and qualifications for County Commissioners as outlined in the West Virginia Constitution and the West Virginia State Code.

The appointee must be available to begin serving as County Commissioner immediately after the appointment. The salary for the appointment is set by W. Va. Code §7-7-4 at \$47,812 annually. The appointee will be eligible to participate in the County's health insurance program.

Interested applicants are requested to submit a cover letter and resume. Cover letters and resumes may be submitted via email or by mail/hand delivery to the Kanawha County Commission Office, attention Jeremy Young, County Manager, 407 Virginia Street, East, Charleston, WV 25301. The Kanawha County Commission will meet on July 23, 2026, at 4:00 p.m. in the Henry C. "Hoppy" Shores Commission Courtroom to select the candidate appointed to fill the vacant position.
