Charleston, WV – Following an executive order from Governor Patrick Morrisey granting state employees a half-day holiday on Thursday, the Kanawha County Courthouse will close at 12 p.m. on Thursday, July 2 ahead of the Independence Day holiday weekend.

The Courthouse will remain closed on Friday, July 3, as an observed county holiday. The Courthouse will reopen for regular business on Monday, July 6.
